

ZONES IN LONDON



IH LONDON SCHOOL

IH London is in Zone 1, in central London, close to Covent Garden, Holborn and Tottenham Court Road underground (Tube) lines.

ACCOMMODATION IN ZONE 1

In Zone 1 we have our student residence Chapter Kings Cross. It means you can walk to the school, or take a very short bus or underground ride. The school is in Zone 1 and most of the major tourist attractions are in this zone.

ACCOMMODATION IN ZONE 2

Zone 2 is an inner London zone and offers a short tube or bus ride to the school, with major tourist attractions within easy reach. It is a residential zone, but still close to all the action. Our student residences Chapter Highbury and Chapter Islington are in Zone 2. We also offer homestay in this area.






